Care

Wash the surface with a solution of warm water and mild detergent. A mild dishwashing soap works well. Rinse the surface of the item well with clear water. Do not allow soaps or detergents to sit for long on the marble because smells can linger in the porous stone.

Because of the porous surface, marble items can become stained from extended exposure to oils, juices, or other colored liquids. Applying a poultice to affected areas can remove stains. You can buy a poultice mixture at hardware stores, or you can make your own.

To make a poultice, combine 1 dl of baking soda with just enough water to form a thick paste. Before you apply the paste, dampen the stain with distilled water to prepare the pores. Next, apply the paste to the stain on the marble, cover the poultice with plastic wrap and tape the edges down to seal in the air. Leave the poultice and the plastic wrap on the stain until the baking soda dries. The poultice will pull the stain out of the marble. Wipe the baking soda off, rinse the stain, and repeat all the steps if any of the stain remains.
